DECEMBER 2018

I share with you what I recently shared in a United Reformed Church Newsletter (which some may have already seen). On Saturday, the 1st December, we begin to open the doors of our Advent Calendars. When I was young we did not have the prospect of chocolates to eat but it was still incredibly exciting to open the door and see what picture was inside. I always liked seeing the pictures that related to the Christmas story. I am sure that I wished away most of the Decembers of my childhood, looking forward with great anticipation to Christmas Day. This year, Sunday, 2nd December, is the first Sunday of Advent in our church calendars. I love the season of Advent, and Christmas. It is wonderful to have a season, however we use that time, to expectantly wait for something to happen. Because, of course, the joy of waiting is not in the agonising slowness of the days passing but in the time that we spend in reflection. For me, Advent is a joyous time of reflection, thinking about the awesomeness of our God, looking forward to the birth of Jesus, God coming to us as a baby, so that we could listen and hear what God is saying to us. So that he can tell us and demonstrate to us how much he loves us. In that sort of waiting and anticipation, we can begin to dream dreams and see beyond those things that tend to distract us. I remember, when I was about ten, sitting in a Christmas carol service, feeling filled with the joy of God and thinking in those moments that I wanted to do something for God in my life. Then, I thought that meant that I might be a missionary! I think we had recently visited David Livingstone's birthplace; I was living in Scotland at the time. But I have never forgotten that moment. Let us embrace Advent, and approach Christmas this year, with that all-consuming passion that children so often show, with that awe of expectancy that seems to get a little lost as we grow older. Even in all the busyness of the season that can so often overtake us as adults let us allow God to speak to us, and, like Mary, let us be ready to hear God calling us to all sorts of extraordinary things as his children.

Have a great month, a reflective Advent, and a peaceful and joyous Christmas, everyone. And a great celebration and a very Happy Birthday if you were born during this month. The peace, the love, and the welcome of our generous God be with you.
